Staff will be in school completing training together focussed on task design that provides challenge for all pupils and helping children to fly high together. We will also be gaining valuable further training in Sensory Circuits, a powerful SEND strategy enabling children to be ready to learn.

- 1) **Hilliers:** The children and staff had a wonderful day at Hilliers today. It is always very rewarding to see children's curiosity and wonder ignited by the beauty and complexity of the natural world.
- 2) **500 Word Stories:** It has been great to see some of the 500 word stories the children have been writing for the 500 word story competition. There is still lots of time for children to complete their stories as the closing date is the start of November. The playful, imaginative ideas and the really positive attitudes the children are demonstrating is really inspiring. Attendance Matters: Well done to Willow Tree and Rowan Tree Classes who topped the attendance charts last week in school. We make no apologies for continually returning to the importance of good attendance for the research is overwhelmingly clear: those whose attendance remains high, make strong progress in all aspects of their learning; those who more regularly miss school are more likely to make slow progress and achieve less well as they go through their schooling journey. 95% attendance is just one day's absence every 4 weeks or just 3 days absence across a whole term.
