Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have had a good week as we draw near to the end of November and the start of December and Advent.

Flying High Together: One of our flying high together highlights this week has been hearing the wonderful **Power for Good Speeches** that children have been delivering to their class this week. It has been inspiring to hear how passionate the children are about using their time, hard work, talents and strengths to make a positive difference in the world we live in. We will be holding our Power for Good Speech Grand Final on Wednesday next week where the winners in each class we deliver their speech to the whole school.

Romsey Abbey Christmas Fair: Tomorrow is the Abbey Christmas Fair between **10am and 2pm in the Abbey**. This is a great community event to usher into Advent with. It is £1 entry for adults and children enter for free (but must be accompanied by an adult. Lots of stalls and games to visit and enjoy. Our school choir are singing as part of the fair and those involved in that have been asked to meet Mrs Maxey at 11:15am in the Abbey in full school uniform ready for performing at 11:30am. Do come along and support the choir and enjoy this family friendly event.

Christmas Jumper non-uniform day: Next Friday (5th December) is our Christmas Jumper Non-School Uniform Day. We ask for a **donation for the School Christmas Tombola of a bottle or a box of chocolates**. These will be collected at the front of school on Friday morning. In return the children can wear a non-school uniform and a chance to get those Christmas jumpers out if desired.

Christmas Family Celebration Event: We will be holding a Christmas Family Celebration event on **Tuesday 16th December between 3:30pm and 4:30pm**. Thank you for those who have offered their help for the event. We are still looking for more volunteers to help set up that afternoon and help run a stall or serve drinks.
