Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have had a great week as we begin this season of Advent.

**Flying High Together:** Wednesday was a real highlight this week. In the morning and early afternoon, I was joined by a fellow headteacher to review teaching and learning across school and they were really impressed by how focused and engaged all the children were in their learning. He was also pleased to see how regularly the children think back to previous learning and have a chance to think more deeply in each lesson.
