Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to December. The frost was out to remind us in case we forgot. Please do take some simple measures to make sure your children stay warm in the colder weather. Whether rain is forecast or not, children should have warm coats for break times and lunchtimes even if when they are leaving the house in the morning they think they don't need one. We also encourage children to be wearing gloves and hats for those times in the school day where they are outside.

**Christmas:** All the school build up to Christmas takes the focus this week. Thank you for all the bottles donated for the Christmas Tombola at the **PTFA Christmas Fair** next **Friday (8th December: 3:15pm).** The children have been very excited to be getting into the festive spirit today with their jumpers, hats, socks etc.

**KS1** and Year R Nativity: The Year R, 1 and 2 children will be performing their Nativity play on Wednesday (6th Dec) and Thursday (7th Dec) next week at 2pm both days in our school hall. These are free but ticketed performances so please ensure you have tickets rather than just turning up as we sadly won't have space to accommodate you - "No room at the inn" as the Innkeeper would say.

**Christmas Service at the Abbey:** On Thursday 14th December, we have our Christmas Service at 2pm in Romsey Abbey. This is led by the KS2 children singing, narrating and performing as they take us through the Christmas story. All parents are welcome to attend and it is not a ticketed event.

**Curriculum Drop Ins:** Part of your feedback at our November Parents Evening identified having regular opportunities to come in and see what the children have been doing in lessons.
