Easter Service: Thursday next week is the final day of term before the Easter Holiday. You are most welcome to join us for our Easter Celebration Service at 2:00pm in Romsey Abbey that afternoon. We encourage children to bring a flower or two that can then be brought forward to help decorate our Easter Cross during the service. If any parents would like the role of decorating the cross with the flowers during the service please do speak to me. We are also going to practice an emergency fire evacuation at the end of the service. It is important we practice our fire procedures in a range of situations to ensure they are effective and understood. At the end of the service the fire alarm in the Abbey will sound and the staff will take the children back to school via the North Door (nearest the school) and register them on the playground as per our usual fire procedure. Parents will be asked to evacuate the Abbey through the South door and will assemble on the grass area outside the Abbey. We will then get the children ready for home and the school gate will open at 3:10pm as normal. We will go through this with the children before Thursday so they are aware that it is happening.
